



Consortium of ASEAN-EU-Fukuoka Universities (CASEUF) Summer Program 2023

Period of Session: Monday, 7 August 2023 – Friday, 18 August 2023
(Arriving at FWU on 5 August; leaving on 19 August)

Organizer and Host: Fukuoka Women's University (FWU)

Participants: 30 students

Eligibility: Eligible students are female students who are

- enrolled in the CASEUF full member universities;
- in good academic standing with a grade point average of 2.3/3.0 or higher (see below for JASSO grade point average scale); and
- proficient in English for academic purposes (at least TOEFL iBT61 or the equivalent).

JASSO: Japan Student Support Organization

Nomination of Participants: CASEUF partner universities are asked to nominate participants. The responsible office in each university should submit their participants' application materials to the FWU International Center no later than 31 May 2023. Two places are reserved for each partner. A scholarship fund of ¥80,000 and a travel expenses subsidy will be granted to each participant.

Application Requirements:

- (1) Completed "Application Form" (Excel)
- (2) A photocopy of an academic transcript at the end of the preceding academic year
- (3) A copy of passport
- (4) A face picture
- (5) A photocopy of an overseas traveler's insurance for the period of stay in Japan
(A copy can be submitted later as soon as purchasing an insurance.)

Participation Fee and Other Expenses:

- Participation fee: ¥40,000
- Wi-Fi router (if necessary)*: ¥2,000 deposit for two weeks (refunded if returned intact)

*Each room in the FWU International House is equipped with wired LAN. You need a router to use wireless LAN.

- The following costs will be charged in case of loss or damage. (These costs are subject to change.)
 - Dormitory IC-key card: ¥2,000
 - Dormitory room key: ¥7,700 + tax
 - Dormitory desk key: ¥6,500 + tax

Scholarship and Travel Expenses Subsidy: Recipient will receive a JASSO/FWU scholarship fund of ¥80,000. According to the requirement by JASSO, all recipients have to submit a “Completion Report” and answer “Feedback Questionnaire” by the deadline. Forms will be provided by FWU.

Maximum ¥30,000 of travel expenses subsidy will be granted to all participants by FWU. This subsidy may cover the return-trip airfare between the international airport nearest to a participant’s home university and Fukuoka Airport.

The scholarship fund and travel expenses subsidy will be paid in cash.
